## AQHA JUNIOR MASTERS HORSEMAN PROGRAM

This will be the first/introductory meeting for all interested in learning about the Junior Master Horseman program (JMH).

The AQHA JMH is a multi-level, experience-based curriculum that uses vibrant characters to lead youth through lessons about horses. Level 1 is comprised of basic information and history and includes a book and fully interactive Web site.

Youth start with the book, which includes the lesson and several reinforcement activities. Then, youth go to the web site to complete several more activities and the comprehension check. When youth complete and pass the check, a certificate is printed out for them on their home computer for immediate reward and recognition.

Students and groups register for the JMH program. In addition, youth have the opportunity to sign up to receive regular newsletters and information from a variety of horse organizations and associations. JMH is a non-breed-specific program.

Finally, a program that teaches the basics of horses that is really fun! When your children have the chance to learn in a fun, interactive environment, they'll retain much more.

The AQHA JMH is a horse-based curriculum developed with engaging characters. Your children will identify with these horsey cartoons & stay acquainted throughout their learning experience.
