Eligibility for NHQHA Open Show Circuit

- A The exhibitor/rider must be a paid NHQHA member before points can be accumulated.
- B Horses must be registered with American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA)
- C All points will be accrued by the same horse/rider combination. Horse/Rider combination does not apply to AQHA Open Classes.
- D A minimum of two (2) points must be accumulated by the end of the year to qualify for Championship awards and one (1) point must be accumulated by the end of the year to qualify for Reserve Championship awards in any division shown in.
- E If a show elects to combine any classes, points will be given to horses in their respective divisions. Example If Youth 13 and Under and Youth 14-18 are combined points earned in Youth 13 and Under will accrue towards the Youth 13 and Under and points earned in Youth 14-18 will accrue towards Youth 14-18.
- F Points will begin to accrue when the membership is paid.
- G Any discrepancies should be directed to the Points Secretary.
- H Pointed shows held between January 1st and December 31st of the current year are eligible.
- I Any exhibitor earning a year end award in lead line or walk trot, may not qualify for any other award that requires additional gaits (i.e. lead liners cannot earn awards in both lead line and walk trot, and walk trot exhibitors may not earn awards in any class requiring a canter. If an exhibitor wishes to move up into a higher division during the same show season, the lower division awards will be forfeited.
- J If there is a tie for year end awards, the Points Secretary will take the exhibitor with the highest point average per class to break the tie, (i.e. 10 points in 10 classes vs. 10 points in 5 classes, the person with the 5 classes will win because the person with the highest average points per class breaks the tie).
- K The Open Show Circuit participants will be required to submit the appropriate form to the Points Secretary by the 15th of the following month.

NHQHA OPEN SHOW CIRCUIT

Horses must be a Quarter Horse registered with American Quarter Horse Association.

Eligible Divisions - The following 15 divisions will be eligible for year end awards.

- 1 Lead Line age 8 and under
Eligible classes - Lead Line Pleasure, Lead Line Equitation and Lead Line Trail
 - 2 Walk Trot 18 & Under
Eligible classes - Walk Trot Pleasure, Walk Trot Equitation, Walk Trot Trail and Walk Trot Showmanship
 - 3 Walk Trot 19 & Over
Eligible classes - Walk Trot Pleasure, Walk Trot Equitation, Walk Trot Trail and Walk Trot Showmanship
 - 4 English Events 18 & Under
English Halter, English Pleasure, English Equitation, English Trail and Showmanship
 - 5 English Events 19 & Over
English Halter, English Pleasure, English Equitation, English Trail and Showmanship
 - 6 Western Events 18 & Under
Western Halter, Western Pleasure, Western Equitation, Western Trail and Showmanship
 - 7 Western Events 19 & Over
Western Halter, Western Pleasure, Western Equitation, Western Trail and Showmanship
 - 8 Walk Trot Gymkhana 18 & Under
Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Stake Race, Egg and Spoon and Command
 - 9 Walk Trot Gymkhana 19 & Over
Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Stake Race, Egg and Spoon and Command
 - 10 Gymkhana 18 & Under
Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Stake Race, Egg and Spoon and Command
 - 11 Gymkhana 19 and Over
Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Stake Race, Egg and Spoon and Command
- Year-end awards for Lead Line and Walk Trot will be pinned 1st through 6th place.

Pointed Shows

Open/fun shows are defined as any horse show, taking place in the State of NH that is not already included in our NHQHA/AQHA Show circuit. Includes but is not limited to 4-H shows, Silver Heels, NHHTA, local barn shows and series.

You may show in up to 10 (ten) open/fun shows of your choice. **IF** you show in any of the NHQHA sponsored open shows listed below, your points for that particular NHQHA show will be doubled.

NHQHA Annual Show/Open Breed Show—**OPEN SHOW PORTION ONLY—June 10-12, 2016**

NHQHA Novice Show/Open Breed Show—**OPEN SHOW PORTION ONLY—June 25, 2016**

NHQHA Novice Show/Open Breed Show—**OPEN SHOW PORTION ONLY—September 18, 2016**

Eligibility for NHQHA All Breed Show Circuit

- A The exhibitor/rider must be a paid NHQHA member before points can be accumulated.
- B Open to All Breeds of horses, EXCLUDES REGISTERED QUARTER HORSES.
- B All points will be accrued by the same horse/rider combination. Horse/Rider combination does not apply to AQHA Open Classes.
- C You must show under a minimum of two (2) NHQHA judges to qualify.
- D A minimum of two (2) points must be accumulated by the end of the year to qualify for Championship awards and one (1) point must be accumulated by the end of the year to qualify for Reserve Championship awards in any division shown in.
- E If a show elects to combine any classes, points will be given to horses in their respective divisions. Example If Youth 13 and Under and Youth 14-18 are combined points earned in Youth 13 and Under will accrue towards the Youth 13 and Under and points earned in Youth 14-18 will accrue towards Youth 14-18.

NHQHA ALL BREED SHOW CIRCUIT

Any breed of horse is eligible, EXCLUDES REGISTERED QUARTER HORSES.

Eligible Divisions – The following four (4) divisions will be eligible for year end awards.

NHQHA Open Breed Walk Trot (18 and Under)
NHQHA Open Breed Walk Trot (19 and Over)
NHQHA Open Breed Youth (18 and Under)
NHQHA Open Breed Adult (19 and Over)

Eligibility for NHQHA AQHA Show Circuit

- A The exhibitor/rider must be a paid NHQHA member before points can be accumulated.
- B Horse must be registered with American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA)
- C All points will be accrued by the same horse/rider combination. Horse/Rider combination does not apply to AQHA Open Classes. In the open division, only horses owned by NHQHA members are eligible for NHQHA points.
- D You must show under a minimum of two (2) NHQHA judges to qualify for each class.
- E A minimum of two (2) points must be accumulated by the end of the year to qualify for Championship awards and one (1) point must be accumulated by the end of the year to qualify for Reserve Championship awards in any division shown in.
- F If a show elects to combine any classes, points will be given to horses in their respective divisions. Example If Youth 13 and Under and Youth 14-18 are combined points earned in Youth 13 and Under will accrue towards the Youth 13 and Under and points earned in Youth 14-18 will accrue towards Youth 14-18.
- G Points will begin to accrue when the membership is paid.
- H Any discrepancies should be directed to the Points Secretary.
- I Pointed shows held between January 1st and December 31st of the current year are eligible.
- J Any exhibitor earning a year end award in lead line or walk trot, may not qualify for any other award that requires additional gaits (i.e. lead liners can not earn awards in both lead line and walk trot, and walk trot exhibitors may not earn awards in any class requiring a canter. NHQHA/AQHA SHOW CIRCUIT

Eligible classes:

Any AQHA classes offered at any AQHA shows in NHQHA, MassQHA, VtQHA, CQHA, MeQHA and R6AQHA, including Novice Shows.

Awarded to the horse and rider combination that has earned the highest amount of total points, with a minimum of 5 points in each of the following categories:

Eligibility

1. Any breed of horse is allowed.
2. Exhibitor/Rider be a member of New Hampshire Quarter Horse Association.
3. Fee of \$10.00 is due per calendar year per rider before hours/miles are calculated.
4. All hours/miles must be submitted on the Log Program Form by December 15th of the same year for award eligibility
5. Any time you ride/drive your horse in New Hampshire you may accumulate hours/mileage.
6. Program starts January 1st of each year.
7. Awards will be presented at the New Hampshire Quarter Horse Association Banquet.

NHQHA Quarter Horse of the Year

Eligibility

1. Horse must be a Quarter Horse registered with American Quarter Horse Association.
2. Must be a member of New Hampshire Quarter Horse Association.
3. Points will start to accrue once your membership has been paid in full.
4. Points will be counted at any NHQHA eligible shows listed below.
5. Must be a resident of the State of New Hampshire.
6. Must show under a minimum of two (2) NHQHA judges.
7. A minimum of two (2) NHQHA points must be accumulated by the end of the year to qualify for this awards.
8. Total points accrued by any exhibitor will be counted, whether it be youth, amateur or open.
